- 10. Give framework mandates for international agreements



- 1. Economics should offer a clear **definition** of "economy" (and "economics")
- 2. Economics should be clear about **the goal** of the "economy" (and "economics")
- 3. Economics should offer **consistent metrics** for success measurement (macro, meso, micro)
- 4. The creation of proper metrics is a **political task**, possibly of all citizens






